



Allocations for memberships.

Please note we reserve the right to make changes to this policy at any time.

- Every organisation currently in receipt of a **Major Grant** will automatically be issued 2 x Memberships. These memberships can't be increased but can be transferred to alternative members of staff due to changes in staffing responsibilities.
- Every **Time to Shine** Leader and their Manager will be issued a Membership, each. If the Time to Shine Manager already has a RankNet login, we will not issue a membership to an alternative member of staff.
- Every Rank Aspire Leader and their Manager will be issued a Membership, each. If the Rank Aspire Manager already has a RankNet login, we will not issue a membership to an alternative member of staff.
- Every **School Leadership Award** Holder will be issued a Membership.
- Match Trading™ organisations will receive a maximum of 2 Memberships. 1 Membership will
 be issued per named participant on the programme, according to the Match Trading contract.
 Due to some organisations having 2 named participants, 2 Memberships would be issued in
 this instance.
- **Profit for Good** organisations will be issued 1 Membership to the key P4G contact. If this contact is already a member of RankNet, the Membership should not be re-allocated to a different member of staff.
- **Repayable Grant** organisations will be issued 2 memberships. If they are already RankNet members due to a previous grant, no new memberships will be issued.
- Winston Churchill Memorial Award Winners (Economy & Enterprise category) will be issued with 1 membership per award winner. These will be issued upon request by the individual.
- Executive recommendations of non-network individuals/organisations will be issued memberships on a case-by-case basis. Unless instructed by an Executive, no extra memberships will be issued to non-network organisations.

RankNet memberships will not be issued to the following:

- Additional members of staff at RankNet member organisations in order to access Opportunities.
- Pebble Grant recipient organisations will not be issued a Membership. The only exception to this is upon Executive request.
- Friends and family of current RankNet members.
- Technical support at member organisations (unless they are eligible members according to the policy above).
- Rank-funded Hospice UK grant recipient organisations.
- Organisations who are not known to the Foundation, or not in receipt of direct Rank funding.

Termination of membership

Membership of RankNet is dependent on engagement and activity. RankNet is not exclusively for currently funded projects/individuals. All members may remain on RankNet so long as they fulfil the following:

- Members log into the platform at least once every 6 months.
- There is evidence of engagement with the network at least once per year (through commenting/submitting a blog/signing up for events etc.).
- Members abide by the terms and conditions provided at the point of signup (see Terms and Conditions).
